

Publishing Interactive Adobe Captivate Presentations as Canvas Assignments

1. Use Captivate to export your presentation as a zipped HTML5 package:

With your presentation open in Captivate, choose **File**, **Publish** from the top menu.




The **Publish for Devices** dialog appears. Enter a **Location** on your local machine in which to save your file, and make sure to check **Zip Files** before clicking the **Publish** button.




2. Import your zipped HTML5 package into Canvas:


In Canvas, choose **Files** from the left menu:




...then click **Upload:**



Select the file you exported from Captivate above, and then click **Open**.




The **Zip File Options** dialog appears; choose **Expand It** to expand its contents into your Canvas Files area.



You will see this progress bar while your file expands...




...and a file listing when the operation completes:




3. Insert a hyperlink to your presentation into a Canvas assignment:

With an assignment open, type the desired text for your new hyperlink and highlight it; then click **index.html** from the Files listing in the right panel.



Now your text should turn blue to indicate an active hyperlink to your imported presentation's **index.html** file.



After you save your new assignment, click your new hyperlink to make sure that your presentation launches normally.
