

Total Collections


over 2.9 Million Items Strong


Focus on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion



Popular Composers • Scores




Faculty and students can check out a wide variety of individual scores and music recordings in the Music Library, and have access to thousands of additional works online.

Digital Collections





Collections in Context




All bars indicate a relative portion of 100% for each inventory category. Colored bars equal distribution of titles & grey bars allocate usage for the academic year.


JMU researchers collaborate with academic institutions around the globe to create scholarly works. The Libraries provide access to much of this important scholarship and to the resources used in its creation.

Patron Demographics




The Libraries' discovery pathways enable JMU scholars of all levels, as well as local citizens, to find and use scholarly resources in a variety of formats.
